

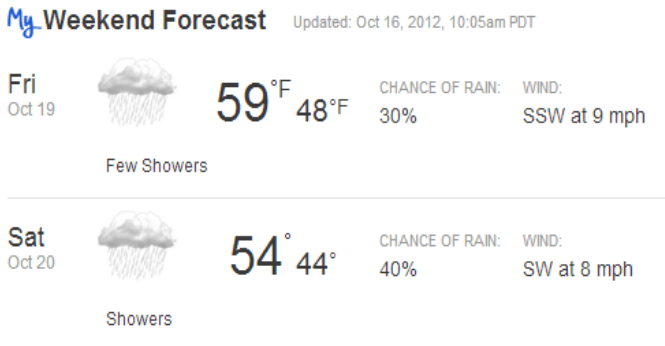
Fall Urban Experience Deets
