In community colleges, C2C Members use peer mentorship and service learning to build student engagement and graduation rates.	College Access Corps members serve at college campuses, non-profits, or K-12 institutions, where they develop, implement or coordinate college access programs within local communities. Members recruit and train college students to act as college access coaches, who provide academic support and exposure to higher education to economically disadvantaged K-12 youth.
