Using an equity lens, VISTAs build capacity, develop programs, and build processes for organizations to address educational inequities and alleviate poverty based on community identified issue areas.	C2C members serve at K-12 schools or community colleges to build equitable pathways for student success. Members develop and implement K-12 academic programs that bolster attendance through mentorship, family engagement, and service learning. In community colleges, C2C Members use the Guided Pathways model, peer mentorship and service learning to build student engagement and graduation rates.	College Access Corps members serve at college campuses, non-profits, or K-12 institutions, where they develop, implement or coordinate post-secondary access programs within local communities. Members recruit and train college students to act as college access coaches, who provide academic support and exposure to post-secondary opportunities to historically marginalized K12 youth.
